### Instrumental Lesson Policy

All students receiving music lessons will be required to pay termly in advance. The fees charged will be £15 for each 30 minute lesson.

GCSE/RSL Music students in years 10, 11, 12 and 13 are charged at **50%** of the above fees provided they attend an extra curricular activity in the music department or Sleaford Music Centre. These students are only entitled to tuition of ONE instrument at 50% off and if they choose to have tuition on an additional instrument, full fees will be charged. A register will be kept and any students who miss **two** extra curricular sessions within a term will have their subsidised lessons withdrawn for the following term until their attendance improves.

If a student misses **three** or more lessons during a term they will be removed from the timetable the following term. They will then need to re-apply for lessons should they wish to continue.

Instrumental timetables will be published at the start of each term. These timetables will incorporate a rotation so that students attend at different times during the academic year, minimising disruption to the main curriculum. It is the student's responsibility to check their weekly time. If they are unsure, they must speak to the Co-Ordinator of Instrumental Music or their instrumental teacher so they can then be informed of their time slot.

Refunds for lessons will only be issued for teacher absence. If the student has prior knowledge of a sports fixture, controlled assessment, hospital appointment etc. they should speak to the Co-Ordinator of Instrumental Music or their instrumental teacher about re-scheduling the lesson. We endeavour to deliver all pre-paid lessons.

Invoices will be issued each term to request payment for the following term's lessons. If payments are not received by the due date, the student will not be timetabled for any further lessons. If the student wishes to resume lessons, they must re-apply and make the payment in advance of starting.

Lessons run continuously throughout the year. Parents or guardians who wish to terminate their child's lessons should provide the Co-ordinator of Instrumental Music a written notification of this cancellation. This needs to be received by the following dates for each term:
