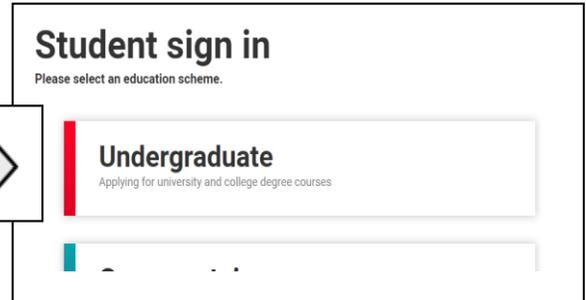
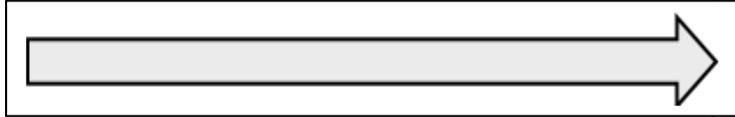


UCAS Registration 2021 Entry

Read everything carefully and follow the instructions.

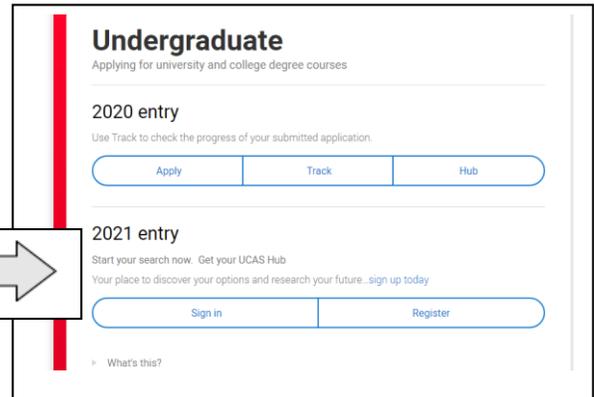
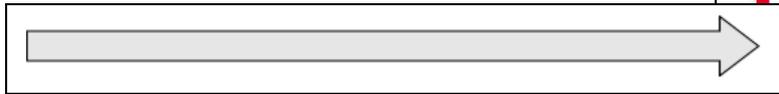
First Steps

Go to UCAS.com/student and select Undergraduate.



Beginning the Registration Process

Select "Start an undergraduate application".

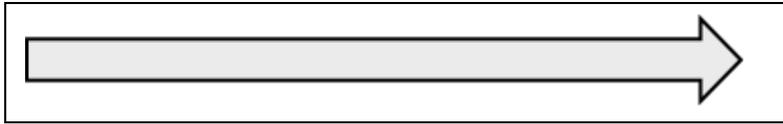


Make sure that you register for the correct year – it is a 2021 start.

Note that parents can also register if they wish to receive separate notifications/emails about the process.

Complete the first stages of registration

In the first instance you need to register, set up a password and provide security questions.



Remember to accept the terms and conditions when asked.

Important

You will be asked to provide an email address. It is vital that you use a sensible one, with no silly, or rude, names. Universities will be using this to contact you and admissions tutors are never impressed by silly email addresses. Also, **this must be a personal address**. You cannot rely on your school email as you will be communicating with universities after you have left.

Very Important Points to Remember

You **MUST** remember to write down your password, username and Personal ID number. There will not be the opportunity to go back for reminders. If you forget them it is quite a long process to ring UCAS. You should email these details to your form tutor who will save them in a secure folder for you. Do NOT rely on screenshots on your phone as these do get lost/broken.

Start your Application

Signing In

Once you have registered you will then be able to sign in. You will first have to activate your username via your email address. UCAS will send a verification number and link so this is a straightforward process.

Linking to the Academy

It is essential that you link your application to the Academy by using a buzzword. This year it is

Academy1

On the declaration page please tick the box to opt in this will enable St George's Academy to assist you by tracking your application. After you have logged in follow all of the prompts, remembering to scroll down to the bottom each page. You need to read the questions carefully and take care to follow instructions.

Completing Your Application

For each section enter as much information as you can. Deadlines will be sent to you as we go through the process. So please watch for emails giving you further information and instructions. Read ALL the guidance available to you. There are extremely informative UCAS videos (on ucas.com which will help guide you through the system. Try to watch them!

Your personal statement will be completed using Unifrog, and further guidance will be sent out about this.

As you log out the form saves automatically with updates. Your application will be checked by you and your form tutor before being sent to Mrs Webster who does a final check before it is submitted to UCAS. This is usually in term 2 of year 13 unless you are applying for: Oxford, Cambridge, Medicine, Dentistry or Veterinary Medicine. Please email us if you are applying for those courses.
