

Work Experience

Part-time jobs

You may decide to look for a part-time job whilst you are in Sixth Form. The Careers Office has a jobs board that is updated weekly with local vacancies. Careers staff will also email you about any available positions so please check your emails regularly.



University Visit/ Employability Day

During Term 6, the Sleaford Joint Sixth Form organise a university and employability day. You can experience first hand a university campus, see the accommodation, take part in a lecture, or a mock interview and find out how to write the perfect CV or personal statement.

Careers Fair

You will be invited to attend the annual Careers and Apprenticeships Fair usually held in March. We usually have around 35 universities and colleges as well as local and national employers. It is a great opportunity to network, and maybe get yourself some work experience or job!
