### Maths Calendars

These have one question to do each day from now until the exams. The questions cover the key skills that are needed on both the higher and foundation papers. If you cannot remember how to do these they are good starting points for your revision, use one of the internet sites, or your revision guide to look it up.

The answers are on the back of each page so that you can check what you have done, but try not to look until you have given it a good attempt.

### Revision Cards

The revision cards cover Geometry, Number, Algebra, Statistics and Ratio. Each card has a question, which leads to a key fact or skill you will need to remember for your exam with the answer on the back. We would suggest carefully cutting these out so that you can test yourself, or ask friends or family to test you.

The new cards are all separately coded in the top right corner:



- The FH or H stands for Foundation and Higher or Higher.
- The G, N, A, S, R stand for Geometry Number, Algebra, Statistics and Ratio.
- The higher the number the higher the challenge (roughly).
- The cards are organised by strand and the higher only cards are on separate pages towards the end of each strand.
